Schooling, however, mandates curriculum which makes a huge mistake in the way spelling and reading is taught. Focus is pulled away from mindful listening to create a false attribution. This error is reinforced each time we ask a child to identify a *letter-sound* or to *sound-out* a printed word. Phonics – and much less fair, skipping and guessing – require unconscious and unnecessary compensations to stay on track. Some learners simply quit the effort.

How can we maintain CORRECT RELATIONSHIPS between speech sounds and alphabet letters? We can show how the speech sounds within relevant words are spelled-out. WordsAhead's sounds-based protocol is a foolproof alternative to “see-say” instruction. Identify unfamiliar vocabulary. Provide the explicit, systematic protocol going from sounds-to-letters.

When and how do I begin?

Easier sooner, harder later. WA-HSSR requires direct teaching of four crucial data sets. Introduce these early and entirely. A comprehensive perspective is pivotal without putting any pressure on the learner for mastery. A confident perspective comes from knowing how to access whatever is needed. Make data sets ubiquitous. The goal of your early teaching should be *familiarity*, not a demand for memory. Understanding takes as long as it takes. Recall always depends on an individual's capacity, focus and motivation.

Chant and sing these sets. Remain devoted to provide equal opportunity and never redact any information. Daily, spend time here until all sets become friendly.

Data Set #1: SOUND UNITS (39 total)

Teach that [brackets] signal pronunciation of a MAP unit. Both within the organizational structure of the MAP and within spoken vocabulary, exaggerate vowel articulations. However, consonant pronunciations do not include a vowel; don't say [C17]+[V04] *b-uhh*. Provide variety with high- and low-pitched voicings.

Data Set #2: SOUND NAMES (39 total)

Teach number-names as shown on your MAP: V01, V02... C16, C17... C22+28... etc. Ambiguous phonics jargon is now obsolete: "Long-Aa" "Bb-Sound" "Hard-Cc" etc.


Data Set #3: ALPHABET LETTERS (52 total)

Teach the relative sizes and shapes of both upper- and lower-case letters Aa–Zz. Use whatever tools are available: apps, building blocks, QWERTY keyboard, sandpaper cutouts, wooden puzzles, worksheets, refrigerator magnets, etc. A variety of fonts and sizings are beneficial. Guide crafting hand-written letters using your favorite schemes.

Data Set #4: LETTER NAMES (26 total)


Teach letter names, both alphabetically and in random order.

Left side of MAP houses VOWELS. Each has equal standing.

Right side of MAP houses CONSONANTS. Notice that vertical columns align with lip and tongue placements. Voiceless+voiced pairs require identical articulation.
